The Boychoir performs seasonal community concerts throughout southeastern Michigan, collaborates with other regional ensembles, and presents our signature traditional "A Boychoir Christmas" every December. Over the years, we have learned that providing a developmental musical space with challenging high quality repertoire provides a valuable experience. - Master's degree, or equivalent choral conducting experience, required; DMA encouraged to apply
- Experience with youth choir highly desirable
- Rehearsal keyboard skills strongly preferred
- Dynamic approach
- Strong communication and organizational abilities
- Passionate, Personable, Patient, Positive, Professional

Position

- Part-time position: Approximately 10 hours/wk
- School year season (~9 months) of weekly rehearsals for multiple ensembles, plus some summer activities such as camps, auditions, planning, and festivals/tours
- Salary range \$10–20k

- Must pass background check
