Choral Skills

Mornings Only or Full Day Camp

Boys' Summer Singing Camp offers enrollment for mornings only camp or a full-day option. Morning music sessions are held from 9:00 a.m. to 12 noon.



Morning singing camp includes small and large group rehearsals, music theory and vocal instruction, as well as team building activities, games, play break, and a snack.



The Boys' Summer Singing Camp Choir will give a performance on Friday, June 19 at 11:30 a.m. at St. Clare Church/Genesis.



The full-day option offers drop-off starting at 8:30 a.m. Afternoon campers eat packed lunches together, followed by a variety of afternoon recreational and enrichment activities, with pick-up between 5:00–5:30.



Afternoons may include visits to local museums, exploring Ann Arbor parks, free play, organized indoor and outdoor group games, ice cream outings, and other fun field trips and activities.
